



Will My Insurance Company Cover Treatment Costs?

What Are the Requirements for Treatment Coverage?

Most people are unaware that their insurance company may provide treatment coverage for **Venous Reflux Disease**. The proper diagnosis and severity of any leg vein disorder should be made with an intensive physical examination and diagnostic ultrasound, despite symptoms or severity. If your initial findings are abnormal, you may be medically eligible for treatment coverage benefits. As with any medical condition, insurance coverage regulations vary depending on your individual plan and diagnosis.

If you are diagnosed with **Venous Reflux Disease**, your insurance carrier may require you to wear medical-grade compression stockings **daily** lasting anywhere from **6 weeks to 3 months duration**. Unfortunately, most insurers will mandate compression stocking therapy as a 'conservative' means of treatment **before** any recommended vein procedure is applied for medical coverage. In select cases, patients may be exempt from this process, depending on diagnosis and previous treatment history.

A prescription is normally issued upon your initial evaluation to obtain medical compression stockings, when needed. Once you complete the required time interval for compression stocking therapy, your records are then submitted to your insurance company for review. Your pre-certification process normally lasts 4 to 6 weeks, depending on insurance provider and processing. Once complete, our staff will contact you regarding treatment coverage approval and procedure scheduling within our office.
